



## Refund Policy

In general, refunds will only be allowed when the player's resignation is the result of,

- (a) a player having registered for a team that is not iced or where the player cannot be placed on a team prior to their first game.
- (a) an injury or medical condition that prohibit a player from playing (a doctor's certificate may be required for any refund citing medical reasons/injury) ;
- (b) a player moving out of Nickel Centre; or
- (d) a first year player of any age not wanting to continue playing hockey prior to their 4<sup>th</sup> practice.

All requests for refunds must be submitted, in writing, to the Association's Registrar and approved by the Executive Committee. This request must be dated and signed by the parent/guardian who registered the player, and contain a reason for the request.

All refunds will be subject to a \$25.00 administrative fee. The remainder of the refund will be based on a pro-rated formula as follows:

- \*\* Before first ice time - 100% of ice fees\*
- \*\* Before October 1 - 80% of ice fees\*
- \*\* Before November 1 - 70% of ice fees\*
- \*\* Before December 1 - 60% of ice fees\*
- \*\* Before January 1 - 50% of ice fees\*

\*All refunds shall be less the current costs of Hockey Canada's Player Registration Certificate (\$40.04 per player effective with the 2005/2006 season) .

The only exception to this formula would be where a team is not iced in the division for which the player has registered or where the player cannot be placed on a team prior to their first game. Individuals falling within these criteria will be entitled to a full refund of registration fees.

No refunds will be issued after January 1<sup>st</sup> unless the player is injured, and will not participate for the remainder of the season, or if the player is moving out of Nickel Centre.

Players suspended by the NCMHA, NOHA, OHF or Hockey Canada are not eligible for refunds.

Please allow 3 weeks for processing from time of notification.

There will be no refunds for any amounts charged by individual teams for rep tryouts.

Please note that receiving a refund from the Association does not necessarily entitle a player to a release. More details on releases are available in the Association's current "Release Policy".
